Introduction

Yintai Investment Company LLC ("Company" or "We") respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This **policy** describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the **website** yintai-us.com (our "**Website**") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This **policy** applies to information we collect:

- On this Website, or
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and this **Website**.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or through any other means, including on any other **website** operated by Company or any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries); or
- Any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries), including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from or through the **Website**.

Children Under the Age of 16

Our **Website** is not intended for children under 16 years of age. No one under age 16 may provide any personal or other information to or on the **Website**. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 16. Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It

We collect several types of information from and about users of our **Website**, including information:

We collect this information:

• Directly from you when you provide it to us.

 Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, web beacons, and other tracking technologies.

Information You Provide to Us

The information we collect on or through our **Website** may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our **Website**.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.
- Your search gueries on the **Website**.

<u>Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies</u>

As you navigate through and interact with our **Website**, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our **Website**, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the **Website**.
- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

The information we collect automatically is only statistical data and does not include personal information, but we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our **Website** and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our **Website** according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to our **Website**.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer.
 You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser.
 However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website.
 Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Website.
- Web Beacons. Pages of our Website and our emails may contain small electronic files known as
 web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit the
 Company, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or opened an email and for
 other related website statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain website content
 and verifying system and server integrity).
- Flash Cookies. Certain features of our Website may use local stored objects (or Flash cookies) to
 collect and store information about your preferences and navigation to, from, and on our
 Website. Flash cookies are not managed by the same browser settings as are used for browser

We do not collect personal information automatically, but we may tie this information to personal information about you that we collect from other sources or you provide to us.

Third-Party Use of Cookies and Other Tracking Technologies

Some content or applications, including advertisements, on the **Website** are served by third-parties, including advertisers, ad networks and servers, content providers, and application providers. These third parties may use cookies [alone or in conjunction with web beacons or other tracking technologies] to collect information about you when you use our **website**. - To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Company's assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Company about our **Website** users is among the assets transferred.
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it. and for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information.
- With your consent.

We may also disclose your personal information:

• To comply with any court order, law, or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.

- To enforce or apply our terms of use and other agreements.
- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Company or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction.

The categories of personal information we may disclose include the information identified herein.

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:
